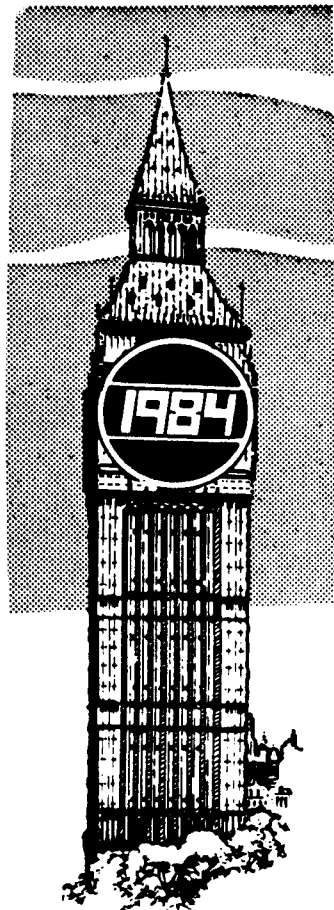

WHAT'S A EUROCON?
